By fostering a digital platform connecting local activists, we create structures that are independent and resilient against behind-the-scenes politics. 3. Individual Freedom and Citizen Oversight:

Freedom begins where citizens can confidently say "No" to injustice, manipulation, and coercion. This requires an active and courageous citizenry, firmly committed to defending their rights through collaborative efforts.

Independence is paramount—we rely on no state funding or sponsorship. To maintain this independence, every observer contributes a nominal amount to cover costs for IT-platform and own used documentation.
